1. Driver's License or State ID Number.

Enter your Alaska Driver's License or State ID number.

2. Date of Birth (REQUIRED)

Enter your birth date. You must be at least 10 years old by starting date of hunt.

Example: February 21, 1966 Month Day Year 02 21 1966

3. Daytime Phone Number (OPTIONAL)

Enter your daytime phone number where you may be reached Monday-Friday 8:00am - 5:00pm Alaska Daylight time (ADT).

4. - 10. Personal Information (REQUIRED)

Print your first name, middle initial and last name. Be sure to include Jr., III, etc. after your last name. Use only capital letters. Remember: your physical address is required if different from your mailing address.

 Your personal information is required in order to mail application results.

11. Community of Principal Residence (REQUIRED)

Enter the community name that is the "true and permanent home from which you have no

home from which you have no present intention of moving and to which you intend to return whenever you are away." This is the physical address where you reside the majority of the time and does not include a recreation cabin or a part-time residence. You may claim only

12. Residency (REQUIRED)

Enter the total years you have resided in Alaska. An Alaska resident is a person who is physically present in Alaska with the intent to remain indefinitely and make a home here, and has maintained that person's domicile (home) in Alaska for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding this application. AS16.05.940(27).

13. Applying for Tier II Hunt (REQUIRED)

Enter the correct hunt number for which you are applying by writing the letter of the species and the 3-digit number for the hunt. For example, if you want to apply for hunt TC566, you would complete the box like this:

If you are applying for MORE THAN one Tier II hunt for this species

Circle the number that indicates if the hunt you are applying for is your 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc, choice for that species. You may apply for multiple hunts per species, but may only receive one Tier II permit for that species. If you qualify for more than one permit per species, your hunt choice preference determines which permit you will receive.

Questions 14-18 are SCORED - If a question is left blank, you will receive the minimum score on that question.

- **14.** Total years YOU have hunted or eaten meat from this population Enter the total number of years you have hunted or eaten meat from the game population you are applying for in Question 13.
- 1.0 point is awarded for each year, for a maximum of 50 points.
- 15. Total years any one household member has hunted or eaten meat from this population. A household member is any person currently living with you in your principal home, excluding persons boarding or renting within your home or relatives living in separate homes. Enter the total number of years this household member has hunted or eaten meat from this game population you are applying for in Question 13.
- .20 points are awarded for each year, for a maximum of 10 points.

16. Within the last regulatory year, now many days did you (the applicant)
spend hunting and/or fishing in this Tier II hunt area? Check the box that
corresponds with the correct number of days you spent hunting and fishing. For
example, if you fished for 14 days in this hunt area last year, and then hunted
for 10 days in this hunt area last year, your total days would equal 24. Select
the box marked "7-27" days.

Applicants can score a maximum of 25 points for this question.

17 & 18: Community Questions. Enter the community that correctly answers these questions. See Tier II supplement for a list of Alaska communities.

- For question 17, applicants can score a maximum of 25 points, unless they are applying for a Unit 13 Tier II hunt, in which case they can score a maximum of 15 points.
- For question 18, applicants can score a maximum score of 30 points, unless they are applying for a Unit 13 Tier II hunt, in which case they can score a maximum of 20 points.

If a question is left blank, you will receive the minimum score (0) for these questions.

- Enter the total number of people living in your household on December 31, 2007 in the box provided.
- 20. Determine the total amount of your taxable household income (adjusted gross income before deductions) in 2007 (rounded up to the nearest dollar) and write it in the boxes provided.
 - A **household** of four or fewer members will receive 0 points on this question if the total taxable income of all **household** members exceeds \$60,950.
- Applicants can score a maximum of 20 points for question 20. Question 19 is used to determine the score awarded in question 20.

REMEMBER....

- Sign the application.
- Do not send money.
- Use only one hunt number per application.
- Enter or check all required information.
- Applicants may be awarded a maximum of one permit per species.
- Each household may be awarded a maximum of one Tier II Moose permit, two Tier II Caribou permits, and one Tier II Muskox permit.
- Applications will not be accepted if postmarked after May 31, or received after June 10.

Signature (REQUIRED)

Read the certification statement carefully. We must reject applications without a signature.
