EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the resident and nonresident goat hunting seasons between the Ferebee River/Glacier and Taiya Inlet from Taiyasanka Harbor north to West Creek, southwest of Skagway, Alaska in Game Management Unit 1(D). This order takes effect at **11:59 pm, Friday November 16, 2012.**

REGULATORY TEXT:

Therefore, the provisions of 5 AAC 85.040, HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR GOAT, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting goat in Unit 1(D):


1 goat by registration permit only.

The remainder of Unit 1D mountain goat seasons, other than those previously closed by emergency order, are not affected by this emergency order.

JUSTIFICATION:

A guideline harvest objective of 1-2 points (male goats=1 point, female goats=2 points) was established by ADF&G for the portion of the Unit 1D between the Ferebee River/Glacier and Taiya Inlet from Taiyasanka Harbor north to West Creek, southwest of Skagway. As of Tuesday, November 14, 2012 two male goats have been taken in the area for a total of 2 points. Because the guideline harvest level has been reached an emergency order has been issued to close the mountain goat hunting season in the area described above at **11:59 pm on Friday, November 16, 2012**. Those portions of Unit 1D not affected by this emergency order, and not previously closed by emergency order, will remain open until the harvest guidelines are reached or the seasons come to their scheduled conclusions.
