### EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the State of Alaska resident and nonresident registration goat hunts (RG890/RG891) in Unit 14A at 11:59 pm, Sunday, October 21, 2018. This emergency order does not affect any other goat hunting regulation in Unit 14.

### REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in **5AAC 84.040 (7), Hunting seasons and bag limits for goat**, are superseded by this emergency order and the following provisions are effective:

**JUSTIFICATION:**

Recent aerial surveys of goats in GMU 14(A) have indicated a goat population of 226 goats. Based on the survey information, a guideline harvest of 13 goats or up to 13 goat harvest points (male goat=1 point & female goat = 2 points) was established for the area. As of Friday, October 19, 2018, the reported harvest is 11 male and 1 female goats (13 points). Additional harvest of goats in this area could have negative impacts to the health of this goat population; therefore, no additional harvest is justified at this.

**DISTRIBUTION:**

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
