**PROPOSAL #18 – ADVISORY COMMITTEES: ARCTIC REGION**

- ▶ Combine the Eastern Arctic Advisory Committee & the Western Arctic Advisory Committee to create a new “North Slope Advisory Committee”
- ▶ Decrease the Committee membership from 30 to 9 members, with a member representative from Barrow, Atqasuk, Anaktuvuk Pass, Kaktovik, Nuiqsut, Point Hope, Point Lay, Wainwright and 1 At-Large member
- ▶ Presently, the North Slope Borough Fish and Game Management Committee exists and meets at least 3 times per year
- ▶ No need for elections. Committee members provide a letter of interest and the local City Councils chooses a primary and alternate member

**NORTH SLOPE BOROUGH DEPT. OF WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT  
FISH AND GAME MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**

- ▶ NSB Fish & Game Management Committee: 1 member from each community plus 1 At-Large member; Meets 3-4 times per year
- ▶ Function of the Committee shall be to develop a comprehensive fish and game management and regulatory policy for the NSB
- ▶ NSB Fish & Game Management Committee serves as a forum to bring together wildlife concerns from communities and provides a way to get wildlife related information back to each community and the department looks to the committee for input and advice
- ▶ NSB Fish & Game Management Committee created in 1976
- ▶ The Dept. of Wildlife Management is to work closely with the NSB F&GMC in developing and implementing management programs for subsistence-use animals. Since this Committee has representation from each village, it is a valuable means for (1) bringing village concerns to the attention of the department and to researchers and state and federal agency representatives typically in attendance; (2) stimulating dialogue on critical issues between members and those researchers and agency representatives present; and (3) assisting in the local coordination of wildlife studies conducted by the NSB and others and state and federal management programs
- ▶ Acts as an Advisory Committee to the State of Alaska ADF&G, Board of Game, Alaska Migratory Bird Co-Management Council, and the U.S. FWS
