Supporting documents AC #4, , RC 27, RC 61 and RC 93

- Echo support for proposal 121, 120, & 126 while finding new conservation measures for Chinook Salmon in the Norton Sound districts 5 & 6, Unalakleet and Shaktoolik
- Call for king salmon sport harvest and catch closure until escapement is met along the Unalakleet River. Table 3 illistrates estimates for Unalakleet River.

Total Sustainable Escapement Goal 1,200 to 2,500 fish. According to report, roughly 25% of the escapement goal is caught. Mortality rates are unknown, however, the "stock of concern" calls for DF&G to error on the side of caution.

2006, according to Table 4\* report suggests no commercial king salmon fishing & subsistence closures effective July 10.

Chinook openings since 2000-Three targeted commercial openings.

Subsistence restrictions & closures occur since 2003

## 2010 Chum Salmon net loss to commercial fishermen

DF&G projected 120,000 chum escaped unmolested by commercial fishermen due to conservation concerns for Chinook salmon. Harvest rate was projected at 60,000. 60,000 x 7 lbs avg x .70= net loss to local fleet of \$290,000 in an economically depressed area. Forgone economic loss local fishermen

Numerous other cases when pink and chum salmon targeted take reduced due to conservation concerns since 2000

#### **TEST FISHING**

The test fishery is not considered to provide a reliable index of king salmon abundance in subdistricts 5 and 6.\*

Two counting methods provide good escapement data, the North River Counting Tower and the Weir along the Unalakleet River. **RECOMMENDATION.** Since test fishery is not a reliable index to king salmon abundance, SNSAC recommendation to cease the use of test nets. This measure will increase the number of fish left unmolested to spawn.
