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Existing PWSMA Salmon Escapement Goals

King Salmon: 1 stock Copper River

Chum Salmon: 5 stocks

Coghill, Eastern, Northern/Unakwik, Northwestern, Southeastern districts

Coho Salmon: 2 stocks

Bering River, Copper River Delta

Pink Salmon: 16 stocks (even- and odd-year brood lines) Coghill, Eastern, Eshamy, Montague, Northern/Unakwik, Northwestern, Southeastern, Southwestern

Sockeye Salmon: 5 stocks

Bering and Upper Copper rivers, Coghill and Eshamy lakes, and Copper River Delta

Approach and Process for Review Committee

- Reviewed available harvest and escapements through 2013 for individual stocks
- Reviewed existing goals to determine whether they were still appropriate given:
 - a. new data collected since last review;
 - b. current assessment techniques; and
 - c. current management practices
- Reviewed the methods used to establish existing goals


Approach and Process for Review Committee

- Updated analyses for stocks that might have resulted in a substantially different escapement goal since the last review
- Considered additional stocks that may have sufficient data to develop a goal

King Salmon – No Changes


1. Copper River SEG: ≥ 24,000
