ADF&G Hunter Access Program

Wildlife Restoration Act (Pittman-Robertson) Funding

- Excise tax collected → U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS)
- USFWS apportions funds to Alaska based on formula
- AK Legislature sets ADF&G DWC's authority (how many PR dollars DWC can spend)
- Proposals evaluated using established criteria
- ADF&G DWC evaluates proposals for funding

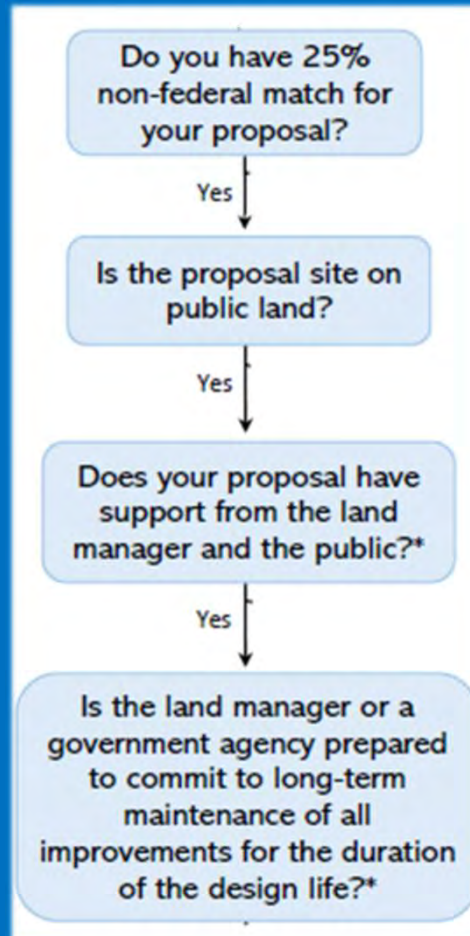

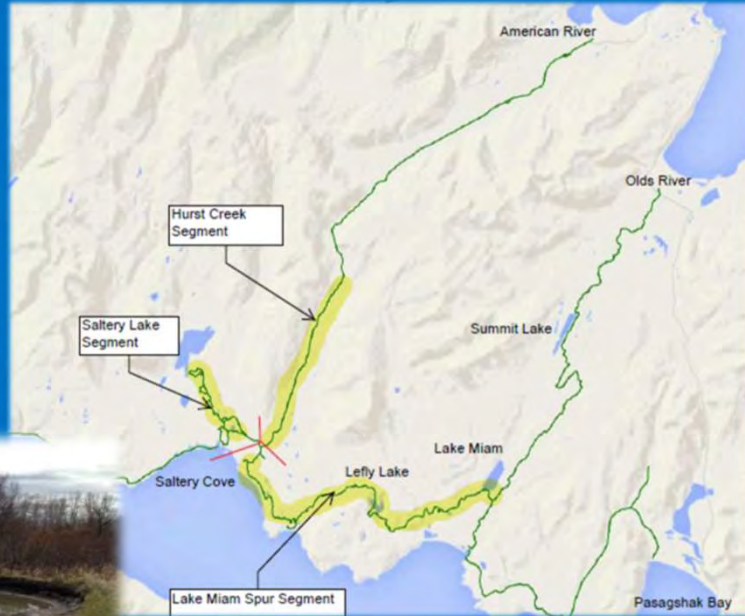

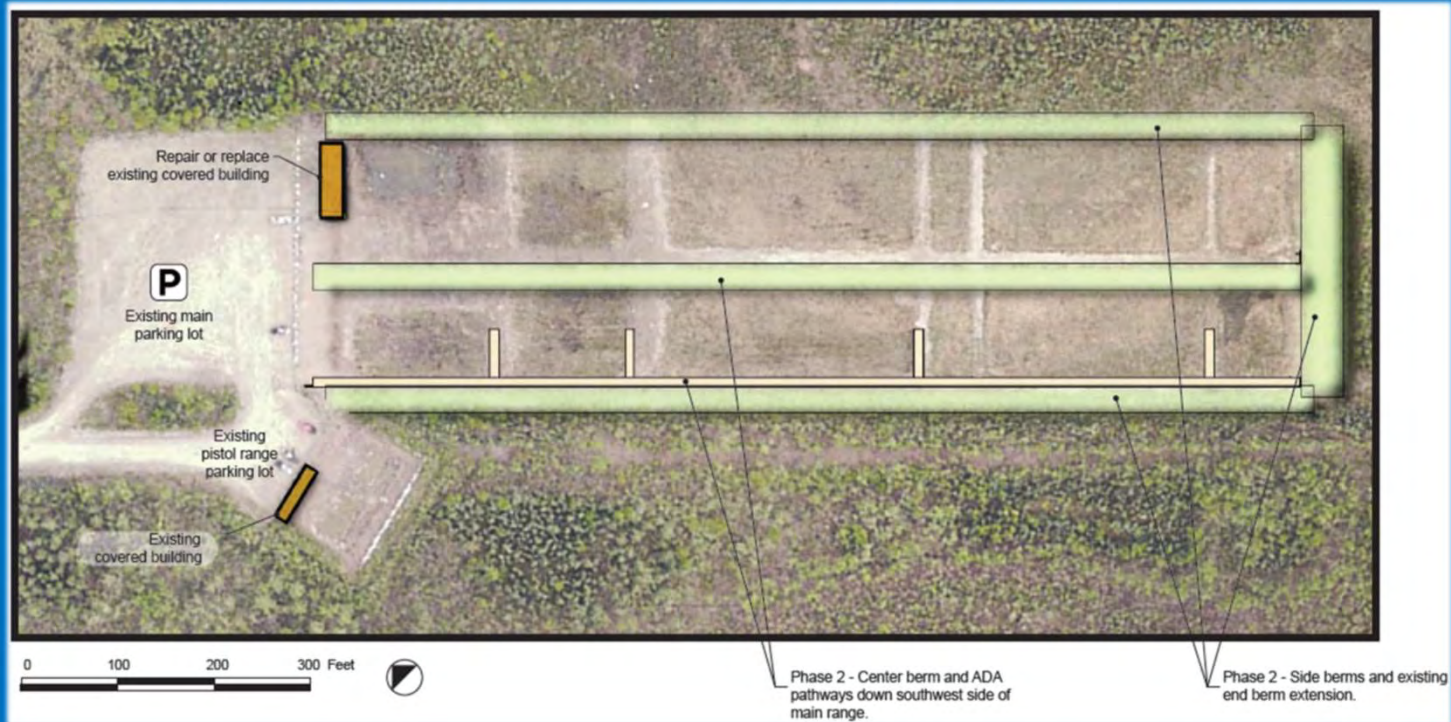
