## A Resolution in Support of Allowing Guides to Take Wolves While Under Contract to Clients

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Game has received proposals to allow guides to harvest wolves while in the field and under contract to clients, and

**WHEREAS**, AS 08.54.720(17) prohibits licensed guides from taking big game while guiding clients, and

**WHEREAS**, as guides and their clients are in the field both spring and fall, and occasionally have opportunity to harvest wolves, and

**WHEREAS**, additional ground shooting of wolves could help avoid the necessity for additional predator control actions, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Game would like to consider regulations to allow this practice in specific areas where ungulate populations need enhancement,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** The Board of Game urges the Alaska Legislature to revise AS 08.54.720 to allow guides to take wolves while guiding.
