RESOLUTION # - Board of Game Soldotna, Alaska 12/8/76

The Board of Game meeting in Soldotna December 8, 1976 has reviewed the Department's plan for control of wolves in limited portions of Units 1B, 3 and 5. The decline to low numbers of deer with little evidence of recovery in the past decade prompts the public, through the legislature, to demand corrective action in the form of wolf control. The Board approves the Department's plan to remove wolves through the use of trapping, fixed wing and helicopter aircraft. The resolution remains in effect until revoked or modified by policy statements of future Board action.
